General

The perennial *Phlox paniculata*, is a member of the family of the *Polemoniaceae*, and originates from North America. Phlox is an excellent filler for a bouquet with a nice fragrance. Bartels Stek offers Phlox varieties perfectly suitable for cut flower production. Their research and development department is working on a 'new generation' *Phlox paniculata*.


The Bartels Stek delivery program includes rooted and un rooted cuttings from below varieties.

Basics

For growing Phlox, temperate climates with cool nights (nights 12-15 °C) are advised. Daytime temperatures should not exceed an average temperature of 25 °C. Production is positively influenced by high light intensities.

Phlox is a quantitative long day plant that requires day length manipulation to speed up the time between flushes. It can handle rain and can be grown in the open, shade netting however is recommended.
