Hypericum

Fact Sheet

General

Hypericum belongs to the family of Clusiaceae, and is commonly known as St. John's-worth. Ornamental species have been bred for their flowers as well as their berries. Hypericum has a nearly worldwide distribution only missing in the tropical lowlands, deserts and polar regions. Hypericum is propagated by cuttings which can be supplied by Bartels Stek. Hypericum is used in fresh flower bouquets. It is a perennial and mainly grown outside with artificial light for "day length manipulation".

Basics

Time from planting to first harvest is 18-20 weeks, depending on the climate and local weather.

Growing temperatures are 15 - 30 °C. Hypericum will grow on any well drained soil and has a regular fertiliser and water requirement.
